Associate membership - points to note

Associate members can enter any group's training/social rides at member's rates. Please note that Associate members have to pay NON-MEMBERS rates for any non-competitive ride run alongside a National ride (for Derbyshire this year that means Carsington and Peak District).

Associate members wishing to upgrade to full membership are entitled to £10 off the joining fee (so you pay £10 joining fee instead of £20). This can be done via Head Office.

Within the Derbyshire Group, Associate members are entitled to a mileage rosette at the end of the season if they return their mileage card to Brenda and have completed 80km or more. There is also a trophy for the Associate member who has completed the most mileage in the season and rosettes will be awarded down to 10th place for this. Associate members are not eligible for the Pleasure Pairs trophy

HELPER'S ROTA

The Helper's Rota is being drawn up at the moment to be published in the next newsletter and will be on the website as soon as it is available. If you wish to help at a particular ride,

please let me know ASAP as this helps considerably to draw up a realistic and workable list.
